**CARRY ON BAG** – Turkish Airlines allows 1 Bag UP TO 17 POUNDS AND UP TO 45 LINEAR INCHES (Length + Width + Height) with maximum dimensions of 9” Deep X 15” Wide X 21” High.

**PERSONAL ITEM** – One personal item such as a purse or camera bag are allowed.

**CARRY ON BAG** – American Airlines allows 1 Bag at no charge UP TO 45 LINEAR INCHES (Length + Width + Height) with maximum dimensions of 9” Deep X 14” Wide X 22” High.

**PERSONAL ITEM** – One personal item such as a purse or camera bag are UP TO 36 LINEAR INCHES (Length + Width + Height).

Plugging In: Please remember the voltage overseas is 220v whereas we are used to 110v here in the United States. You will need the Middle East Adapter to plug in camera and phone charges.

Money: Make sure you take smaller bills with you to Israel. Israel accepts US Dollars everywhere you will go. We recommend you have at least \$50.00 in one dollar bills. Bottled water will be available on the bus at \$1.00 per bottle. The smaller gift shops may not take credit cards or be able to make change for larger bills. Most of your lunch stops will not accept credit cards and lunches can run \$12-15 per day. The larger shops and restaurants will accept credit cards Visa and MasterCard are the most widely accepted card. American Express and Discover may be accepted at some locations.

Phones: Please check with your cell phone provider before traveling to make sure you are aware of the roaming and international calling charges you may be charged. We do have a company we use within Israel for phone rentals. Their brochure is attached. This may be a good option for you.
